
### Aquarium visit!




## November Luncheon

# CPA DAY OF SERVICE



The state-wide OSCPA Day of Service was held on October 24<sup>th</sup>. We had a total of 14 CPA's and 13 University of Tulsa Beta Alpha Psi students spend at least part of their day at the Eastern Oklahoma Community Food Bank. The morning crew bagged individual items for the "Senior Servings" program and was able to bag 4588 pounds of food that would feed 458 seniors for a week-end. The afternoon crew finished the "Senior Servings" food bags (another 2500 pounds of food) and then took a seven foot high bag of corn flakes and put it in individual bags. It was a fun day of service to the community and the CPA's are already looking forward to doing it again next year.
